

LIONESSE OF THE YEAR AWARD  
MULTIPLE DISTRICT 14

PURPOSE:

To define the guidelines and qualifications for the Multiple District 14 Lioness of the Year Award.

GENERAL:

1. Each sub-district may present one (1) Lioness for the Lioness of the Year Award.
2. The following is the criteria to earn this award:
  - a. The Lioness Club must be sponsored by a Lions Club
  - b. The Lioness must be a member in a Lioness Club in good standing in a sub-district
  - c. Have served as a member for at least six (6) years
  - d. Have earned 5 years perfect attendance
  - e. Shall have promoted goodwill and harmony in the Club
  - f. Shall have served as Club President, Secretary or a member of the Board of Directors in the Club and have displayed exemplary service
  - g. If the sub-district has a Lioness District, the Lioness shall have participated in sub-district projects and attended sub-district meetings
  - h. A Lioness may only receive the award one (1) time
3. The application for the award shall be signed by the Lioness Club President and/ or Secretary, the District Governor and forwarded to the Multiple District 14 Lioness Chairperson by March 1<sup>st</sup> of the Lions year which the award will be presented.
4. The award will be presented at the Lioness breakfast or Lioness Seminar at the State Convention:
  - a. If the awardee is not present at the convention, the award will be given to the District Governor to be presented at an appropriate function in the district
