

ASSISTANT CABINET TREASURER

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to create the office of Assistant Cabinet Treasurer.

GENERAL:

1. The District Governor shall appoint at his/her discretion a Lion to the position of Assistant Cabinet Treasurer. Preferably, the Assistant Cabinet Treasurer should be a knowledgeable Lion. It would help to facilitate their interactions, if this Lion resides near or in proximity to the Cabinet Treasurer's home. It is not required that this Lion comes from the District Governor's or Cabinet Treasurer's own Club. It does help a great deal, though, that the two are mutually compatible.

2. The Assistant Cabinet Treasurer will be under the supervision of the District Governor and the Cabinet Treasurer.

3. The Assistant Cabinet Treasurer shall attend all Cabinet meetings (regular or special) and assist in carrying out the Cabinet Treasurer's duties, learning the skills and responsibilities necessary to assume that position.

4. The Assistant Cabinet Treasurer shall become knowledgeable with the duties and responsibilities as suggested and required by the Constitution and By-Laws of District 14-N, Multiple District 14, Lions International and District 14-N Policy Manual.

5. The Assistant Cabinet Treasurer shall have no vote on any matters pertaining to or considered by the District 14-N Cabinet.

6. If the Cabinet Treasurer becomes incapacitated or fails to fulfill his duties, the District Governor shall replace him/her with the Assistant Cabinet Treasurer, at which time the Assistant Cabinet Treasurer will have the same privileges and voting rights as the Cabinet Treasurer.
