

DIABETES AWARENESS COMMITTEE

PURPOSE:

The Principle function of the Diabetes Awareness Committee is to inform the Lions, Lioness and Leos of District 14-N of the effects of Diabetes on our society and its related impact to the health and well being of us all.

GENERAL:

The committee (consisting of a chairperson and five (5) Lions, one from each Region) shall work with the District Governor to assist him/her with the responsibilities of informing, educating and soliciting research assistance related to Diabetes and its inherent problems including blindness. Its specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Promote a better knowledge to all Lions, Lioness and Leos of the importance of Diabetes screening.
2. Work with any or all Clubs desiring Diabetes screening programs.
3. Provide programs as requested for Clubs to make them more aware of Diabetes and its impact on us all.
4. Provide a written report at Cabinet Meetings to update the Cabinet of its progress.
5. Coordinate with Sight Conservations and Work with the Blind Committee to encourage funds for local and State Diabetes research.
6. Coordinate with the LCIF Committee to utilize its efforts in International Diabetes Research.
