

DISTRICT ENVIRONMENTAL CHAIRPERSON

PURPOSE:

The District Environmental Chairperson is appointed by the District Governor and serves as his chief expert and advisor in the areas of environmental services. He provides liaison for all environmental activities within District 14-N and between the District and International Headquarters. His task is to motivate and educate District Clubs to conduct meaningful environmental service activities. His specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Familiarize himself with the Policy Statement of Lions Clubs International "On the Human Environment."
2. Be aware of environmental literature available from the International Headquarters, from District 14-N, and from other environmental agencies and organizations so that he has an overall view of involvement in environmental services.
3. Become familiar with past and current environmental activities conducted by the Lions in District 14-N.
 - A. Evaluate the relevancy of current environmental activities conducted by the Lions of District 14-N, being sensitive to possible outdated programs and their continued relevancy in the light of local needs and culture.
 - B. Be aware of new and relevant project ideas for District 14-N Clubs.

4. Personally visit as many Clubs as possible and educate others: Such as Region Chairperson, Zone Chairperson and Club Officers on environmental subjects.

5. Submit information on exceptional environmental activities to the various District and Multiple District and International Publications.

6. Prepare a report, at the end of his term of office, on the most outstanding environmental activities conducted by the Lions of District 14-N. Each activity should be reported in detail. It should be sent to the International Activities and Program Development Division of International Headquarters. It will assist the Board and administrative staff in making decisions to adopt, amplify or discontinue a particular activity program.
