

LIONS YOUTH OUTREACH PROGRAM COMMITTEE

PURPOSE:

The principle function of the Lions Youth Outreach Program Committee is to provide guidelines that will assist individual Club Chairpersons in their cooperative efforts to administrate an effective Drug and Alcohol Awareness Program.

GENERAL:

The Committee (consisting of a Chairperson and five (5) Lions, one \from each Region) shall work with the District Governor to assist him/her with the responsibilities to provide an effective Drug and Alcohol Abuse Program. Its specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Work as a Liaison between the District 14-N Cabinet and individual Club Drug and Alcohol Abuse Awareness Chairpersons.
2. Encourage all Clubs of the District to have an active Drug and Alcohol Abuse Awareness Program.
3. Encourage each Club to follow the International Association's goals and the District's goals in the establishment and administration of the program.
4. Supply each Club Chairperson with various ideas in available programs and resources.

5. Provide definite goals and realistic plans that are workable to attain these goals.
6. Provide short- and long-range plans that will assure continuity of the District Program as administrations change leadership.
7. Assist the Club Program Chairperson, when called upon, of the Drug and Alcohol Abuse Awareness Program and the implementation of an effective program.
8. Serve as the liaison between Pennsylvania Government State Agencies and the District.
9. Form a news network between the District and individual Club Chairpersons to promote ideas and encourage their participation.
10. Present a progress report of the activities of the District Program at the District Cabinet Meetings.
11. Plan, work and cooperate with other groups and organizations such as Chemical People, Task Force, etc., to avoid duplication.
