

**HEARING RESEARCH COMMITTEE**

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the committee shall be to serve the District by providing liaison for Clubs, District, International Hearing and Work with the Deaf and Hearing Impaired. In addition, the committee shall act as information specialists in the field, be well informed and familiarize the District Lions of their responsibilities. Finally, the committee shall exhibit leadership qualities to motivate and encourage each Club in the District to initiate, improve and/or expand their work in the area of Hearing Conservation and Deaf Services.

**GENERAL:**

The Committee (consisting of a chairperson and five (5) Lions; one from each Region) shall work with the District Governor to assist with the responsibilities to provide an effective Hearing and Deaf Services Program. Its specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Represent District 14-N on the Board of Directors of Pennsylvania Lions Hearing Research Foundation, Inc.
2. Encourage District 14-N financial support to the Pennsylvania Lions Hearing Research Foundation, Inc.

3. Present programs on Hearing Conservation to any Club when requested at their regular meetings.
4. Attend District 14-N Cabinet Meetings with update reports.
5. Encourage all Clubs to provide photographs, brochures and newspaper clippings on the Hearing and Deaf Services activities in their Clubs.
6. Carry out any other duties relating to District 14-N's Hearing Activity that may be assigned to them by the District Governor.
