

LIONS RECYCLE FOR SIGHT

EYEGLOSS COMMITTEE

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the District Governor to hold an effective Eyeglass Recycling program. The work of the Eyeglass Recycling Committee should be to assist in this District-wide activity.

GENERAL:

1. The District Governor shall appoint a committee consisting of one (1) Lion from each Region in Sub-District 14-N. The Chairperson of the committee shall be appointed from within the committee.
2. It is suggested that the Eyeglass Recycling Days be during the month of May or at such a time that is more convenient to the individual Clubs.
3. Each Club should be encouraged to stay within their community limits while collecting eyeglasses. They should not cross over into another Club's limits without proper agreement.
4. Individual Clubs are encouraged to use Lions International "IAD 409 RECYCLE FOR SIGHT MATERIALS ORDER FORM" to collect eyeglasses. Use this form to order the materials you will need for your recycling campaign, particularly CODE NO. KITRFS and CODE NO. IAD 401.
5. Reports are to be made to the Eyeglass Committee and on the M&A's as soon as possible. Include man-hours, amount collected, number of members collecting, etc. It is suggested that the RECYCLE FOR SIGHT REPORTING FORM be used as shown in IAD 401.
