

POLICY ON EMERGENCY DECISIONS

PURPOSE:

To provide a means for making decisions on EMERGENCY subjects when it is impossible to convene or poll the entire District Cabinet.

GENERAL:

At any time between regular meetings of the District Cabinet, when AN EMERGENCY arises that should have the attention of the entire Cabinet, and which must be decided in a short time, and it not being practical to call a special meeting of the Cabinet, decisions may be made by a majority vote of an Executive Committee consisting of the District Governor, Immediate Past District Governor, First and Second Vice District Governors, Cabinet Secretary and/or Treasurer, Region Chairpersons and Zone Chairpersons. Such decisions may be made by holding a meeting of the Executive Committee at a central location, or by polling them by telephone. Such decisions shall be reported and ratified at the next regular Cabinet meeting and duly recorded.
