

HONORARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Honorary Advisory Committee is to serve the District as an advisory body for the District Governor and any Cabinet member who may need assistance in procedure or knowledge to do his job for the benefit of the District.

GENERAL:

The Committee shall be made up of all Past District Governors within the District who are members in good standing of a Lions Club in good standing with the District. Their specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Assist the District Governor with any special problem or responsibility as requested.
2. Advise the District Governor and/or any Cabinet member who may ask for any assistance with the function of his job.
3. There shall be nominations and elections of the Chairperson and Secretary of the Honorary Advisory Committee at the August Cabinet meeting. No Chairperson will serve two (2) years consecutively, although he/she may serve in future years.

4. Keep knowledgeable of the District Constitution and By-Laws and the Policy of the District.
5. Keep knowledgeable of all Cabinet Activities in order to assist those who have accepted leadership positions.
6. Be prepared to meet at the call of the Chairperson, Immediate Past District Governor, on any special problem that may come up within the District.
7. Meet at least four (4) times during the Lions' year, preferably at District Cabinet Meetings.
